



Uniform Guidelines

Uniform checklist (Girls)

- Blazers must be worn to and from school and throughout the day. They may be removed in class
- Shirts should be tucked in, the top button fastened and ties worn neatly
- Coloured or patterned T-shirts should not be worn under shirts
- The regulation skirt should be worn to the knee and not rolled up
- Shoes should be plain black leather or leather look (both upper and sole) with heels not more than 6 cm in height and broad-based. Canvas, fabric, decorated or patent look shoes are not permitted. Leather look trainers/sports shoes are also not permitted
- Jewellery should not be worn. The only exceptions to this are: one plain ring and one single small ear stud or sleeper may be worn in each ear. No other piercings are permitted
- Hairstyles should be tidy and unobtrusive. Hair should not be conspicuously coloured
- Coloured nail varnish, tattoos, obtrusive make-up are not permitted
- Only the regulation school scarf should be worn
- Non-regulation hooded tops (hoodies) are not permitted. Regulation hooded tops that are worn for particular activities are permissible for wear only during these activities
- The regulation Spray Top may be worn as a coat over the blazer outside school
- Large items such as water bottles should not be carried in pockets.

Uniform checklist (Boys)

- Blazers must be worn to and from school and throughout the day. They may be removed in class
- Shirts should be tucked in, the top button fastened and ties worn neatly
- Coloured or patterned T-shirts should not be worn under shirts
- Shoes should be plain black leather or leather look (both upper and sole). Canvas, fabric, decorated or patent look shoes are not permitted. Leather look trainers/ sports shoes are also not permitted.
- Only grey socks should be worn
- Hair should be above the collar and hairstyles should be tidy and unobtrusive. Hair should not be conspicuously coloured or shaven to extreme i.e. no scalp showing.
- Boys should be clean shaven
- Jewellery should not be worn. The only exceptions to this are one plain ring. No piercings are permitted
- Tattoos and obtrusive make-up are not permitted
- Only the regulation school scarf should be worn
- Non-regulation hooded tops (hoodies) are not permitted. Regulation hooded tops that are worn for particular activities are permissible for wear only during these activities
- The regulation Spray Top may be worn as a coat over the blazer outside school
- Large items such as water bottles should not be carried in pockets.
