Each Student Council Rep/ Form captain/Deputy Form captain, with the help of their form teacher, will co-ordinate the allocation and collection of the items for their form's Christmas Hamper. To try to make the process easier and ensure a good range of items for the hampers, a list of items has been created.

Instructions for form time:

- 1. Allocate the 30 items on the Christmas hamper list. Each member of your form class who wants to get involved takes responsibility for getting 1 or 2 of the items in the list for the hamper. Record the names beside each item.
- 2. Remember to only include long term non perishables Use by/Best before dates for 2021.
- 3. Pupils return their allocated items to their form class (or other agreed room) by Monday 7th December. Make sure their name is ticked off once they have brought their items in.
- 4. Bags for life will be supplied to each form class for collecting the items in.
- 5. With the help of your form teacher, keep a record of:
 - (a) the items which have been collected for the hamper
 - (b) the pupils who have contributed to the hamper.
- 6. House points are going to be given to all pupils who have contributed to the Christmas hampers.
- 7. Bags will be collected from the form rooms on <u>Tuesday 8th December</u>.
