Dear Parent/Guardian

I hope this finds you well and that you and your family have enjoyed a good Christmas together. You will be aware that the Minister of Education made an announcement this morning regarding the beginning of the new Spring Term. In light of this I write to outline our arrangements for the start of term.

- Our Staff INSET Day for Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021 will go ahead as planned
- Pupils in Years 8-11 will be taught remotely from 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to Friday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2021.
- Pupils in Years 13 and 14 will be taught remotely from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Face to face teaching in school will resume for them on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021
- The arrangements for pupils in Year 12 as outlined in my letter at the end of last term still stand, namely that Year 12 pupils will be working from home from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021 to Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2021 except when they have a GCSE module or a mock examination in school. In line with the Minister of Education's announcement, GCSE modules and our mock examinations will continue as planned in a manner compliant with Public Health Advice. - In line with the Minister of Education's announcement we will accommodate vulnerable children and children of key workers from the start of term in school.
