Taking place from late June to end of August, projects are carried out virtually with some visits to project hosts' sites, where possible, and last 4 weeks. Projects will be supervised and validated by local universities and professional organisations. Subject areas covered by placements include: biomedical science; biochemistry; neuroscience; environmental biology; chemistry; quantitative social science; psychology; geography; engineering; astrophysics; maths; computer science/IT.
