Cambridge University - Virtual Pre-University Summer Programme is now open for student bookings. They will be offering two entry points:

Option 1: Monday 3 July to Friday 14 July 2023

Option 2: Monday 24 July to Friday 4 August 2023



Aimed at 16- to 18-year-olds, this two-week programme provides students from across the globe with an opportunity to explore a wide variety of subjects as they prepare for future undergraduate study at leading universities.

The programme is taught largely through pre-recorded talks delivered by Cambridge academics and invited subject specialists, with the requirement for students to respond, on a daily basis, to many of these talks on a shared student forum. The programme also offers sessions on study skills, careers, and how to apply to a UK University. Live Zoom sessions will also give students the opportunity to talk to current Cambridge undergraduates, as well as the Programme Director, Dr James Grime. The programme provides students with a safe – and affordable – way to experience university-level material, to expand their horizons, and to question their own subject choice and motivation for study at a leading global institution. The Sentinus Research Academy gives students in Year 13 the opportunity to experience real research and development projects, hosted by local companies and organisations. Taking place from late June to end of August, projects are carried out virtually with some visits to project hosts' sites, where possible, and last 4 weeks. Projects will be supervised and validated by local universities and professional organisations. Subject areas covered by placements include: biomedical science; biochemistry; neuroscience; environmental biology; chemistry; quantitative social science; psychology; geography; engineering; astrophysics; maths; computer science/IT.

Year 13 - Sutton Trust Summer School – Applications Open Now

The Sutton Trust Summer School in 2023 will take place from 7th until 11th August. This will involve some online sessions followed by a 3 night residential. The University of Glasgow joins 12 other leading UK universities in partnership with the Sutton Trust to offer a week-long summer school aimed at Year 13 pupils. The summer school provides students with an opportunity to learn more about university life. Successful applicants will attend academic sessions on a variety of subjects and hear from current undergraduate students about what studying at Glasgow is like. The summer school also provides an opportunity to meet other students with similar interests. They offer six different subject streams to match your academic interests: Arts & Humanities, Common Law, Engineering, Life Sciences, Medical Sciences and Social Sciences.
