Option 1: Monday 3 July to Friday 14 July 2023

Option 2: Monday 24 July to Friday 4 August 2023



Aimed at 16- to 18-year-olds, this two-week programme provides students from across the globe with an opportunity to explore a wide variety of subjects as they prepare for future undergraduate study at leading universities.

The programme is taught largely through pre-recorded talks delivered by Cambridge academics and invited subject specialists, with the requirement for students to respond, on a daily basis, to many of these talks on a shared student forum. The programme also offers sessions on study skills, careers, and how to apply to a UK University. Live Zoom sessions will also give students the opportunity to talk to current Cambridge undergraduates, as well as the Programme Director, Dr James Grime. The programme provides students with a safe – and affordable – way to experience university-level material, to expand their horizons, and to question their own subject choice and motivation for study at a leading global institution. Taking place from 5th to the 7th of July, this Summer Residential opportunity will be fully funded including flights, accommodation, and meals.

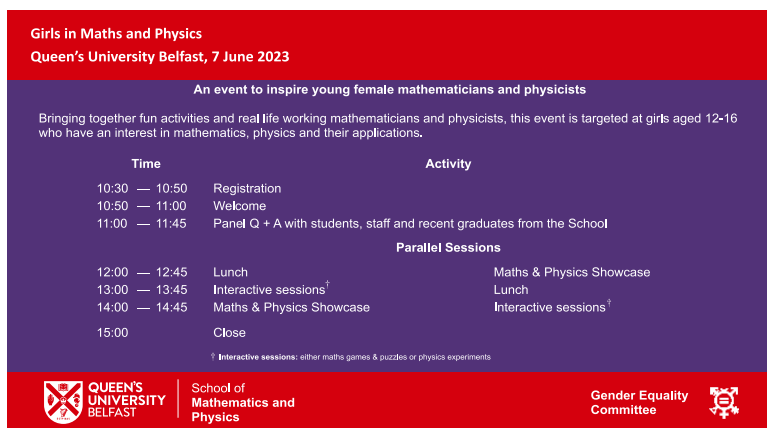
