Aimed at 16- to 18-year-olds, this two-week programme provides students from across the globe with an opportunity to explore a wide variety of subjects as they prepare for future undergraduate study at leading universities.

The programme is taught largely through pre-recorded talks delivered by Cambridge academics and invited subject specialists, with the requirement for students to respond, on a daily basis, to many of these talks on a shared student forum. The programme also offers sessions on study skills, careers, and how to apply to a UK University. Live Zoom sessions will also give students the opportunity to talk to current Cambridge undergraduates, as well as the Programme Director, Dr James Grime. The programme provides students with a safe – and affordable – way to experience university-level material, to expand their horizons, and to question their own subject choice and motivation for study at a leading global institution.
