Atlantic Technological University (ATU) Access Northern Ireland(NI) Course

The Access NI course provides the following benefits:

- Gives direct entry to multiple undergraduate degree programmes available at ATU (list attached)
- Is aimed at students who are doing a mixture of A-levels and other awards such as BTEC's
- Is running FREE of charge - no cost to the student participant
- Is running ONLINE – 2 evenings per week
- Begins in early March
- Is a stand alone 30 credit qualification - a level 6 qualification which equates to a level 4 programme in NI.
