Engineering Development Trust are delighted to let you know that they are now accepting applications for their extremely popular Virtual Insight into University course. *This course is a comprehensive virtual experience allowing students to explore STEM studies at university and the career opportunities that these subjects can lead to. It will also give students access to information on student life, STEM projects and activities set by leading UK universities and global STEM companies, first year undergraduate lectures, live interactive sessions with academics, admissions tutors, employers and current students.*

The course will run during the period **1st July – 23rd August 2024** and can be completed flexibility to fit around other commitments. On completion of the course which involves 30hrs of study, students will receive a **Silver Industrial Cadets Award**.
