**A-level, Cambridge** is a specialist and free programme designed to support high-achieving students from underrepresented backgrounds and across make competitive applications to the University of Cambridge. It's for students in Year 12 who intend to make an application to Cambridge in October 2024 for entry in October 2025.

The programme will be delivered by Cambridge staff and Admissions Tutors who will be sharing their expertise on the application process.

#### **CEM has now opened again for applications (some exceptions apply)**

Students can now apply for their preferred courses by logging onto [www.cem.ac.uk](http://www.cem.ac.uk) and submitting a simple application form. It is important to note:

- Closing date is the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2024.
- Students should input course choices in order of preference, putting their preferred course number 1.
- Students should apply for both L&T courses as well as their L&B choices.
- Applications fee is £45.
- Students will be able to change their mind on their choices from the 1<sup>st</sup> of May until 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2024.

Non-fee-paying students can apply for a course **tuition fees and maintenance grant** through Student Universal Support Team (SUST). Applications are now opened for these grants and students can apply on [www.cem.ac.uk](http://www.cem.ac.uk).
