Student Finance NI - Closing date for Applications this Year is 30 April 2024!!

The Student Loans Company portal for 2024/25 online applications has been open for the last few weeks. Pupils can access it via the www.studentfinancenico.uk This website contains information for students and parents as well as forms and guides which can be downloaded as required.

The closing date for applications this year is 30 April 2024, although applications should be made as soon as possible. Pupils who receive EMA already have an account with the Student Loans Company and must apply for Student Finance using their EMA Customer Reference Number (11-digit number). They should not create a new account or their support will be delayed.

All pupils should apply using either the name on their EMA account or the exact name on their passport or birth certificate. Pupils with a UK passport can input their passport details online. Household income details should be completed online by parents as soon as the student's online application is submitted. Verification to confirm any income should be sent to their local Student Finance office at the same time.

CAO has now opened again for applications (some exceptions apply).

Students can now apply for their preferred courses by logging onto www.cao.ie and submitting a simple application form. It is important to note:

- Closing date is the 1st of May 2024.
- Students should input course choices in order of preference, putting their preferred course number 1.
- Students should apply for both L6/7 courses as well as their L8 choices.
- Application fee is €60.
- Students will be able to change their mind on their chosen from the 7th of May until 1st of July 2024.

Northern Ireland students can apply for a means tested **fees and maintenance grant** through Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI). Applications are now opened for these grant and students can apply on www.susi.ie
