
The unique event will provide the opportunity for parents, guardians and young people to have a personal video or voice call appointment with a member of the Higher Education curriculum team at South West College.

Other opportunities for school leavers include the Accounting Flying Start Programme at Newcastle, Nottingham, Reading, Manchester and Queen Mary University of London universities. This programme will put students on track to becoming an ICAEW Chartered Accountant, completing 80% of their ICAEW exams on the degree, and will be just over a year away from the full qualification once they graduate. Students will also gain a degree and a range of work experience with PwC over the four years. Students apply via UCAS for this programme and can apply for multiple Accounting Flying Start programmes, but each application to each University will count as one of your UCAS options.
