Ulster University UGenie 2025

The School of Biomedical Sciences at Ulster University is delighted to announce that their Garfield-Weston funded Gene Editing Academy (UGenie) is now open to all current year 13s for 2025 entry. This will be the second year of UGenie and they will be building on the incredible success they had with the academy in 2024. This year, the academy will run from Monday 4th to Friday 8th August 2025 on the Coleraine campus, with travel and lunch covered. This may be of interest to pupils studying A' level Biology or Life and Health Sciences, as the content will be consistent with aspects of the curriculum for these subjects. Overall, the course is designed to help students develop basic laboratory skills (microbiology, pipetting, DNA extraction, PCR, electrophoresis) via a number of cutting edge gene editing experiments they have developed for 'beginner genetic engineers'. UGenie will also provide an opportunity for students to gain experience studying on the Coleraine campus, where they can engage with staff, PhD researchers and current undergrads, explore facilities, and experience university life.

ATU - CAO Applications Still Open

The CAO is still open for applications until the **1st of May**, and it's a simple process – there is no personal statement required, and ATU does not require a second language for entry. This is the **final deadline** for students to apply to ATU and other ROI universities for 2025/26. From the 6th of May students who have already applied can use the Change of Mind facility to add, remove, or reorder their programme choices up until 1st of July free of charge. This gives them flexibility as they refine their options.
