All are committed to supporting students from low-income backgrounds in their pursuit of a career in business.
- The SMBP Work Insight and Skills Experience (WISE) offers structured Gatsby Benchmark-ed work insight for 16 – 18-year-old students (Year 13 and 14) from low socio-economic backgrounds.
- SMBP WISE Weeks are free to attend, with travel and lunch provided.
- The **Belfast WISE Week will take place from 23rd – 26th June 2025**. Students will visit 5 high profile organisations which could include: MCS Group, Herbert Smith Freehills, EY, BT, A&O Shearman, Thales UK Ltd, and Ulster University.
- Students will develop skills in communication, teamwork, and problem solving through taking part in creative business-like tasks. They will learn about a day-in-the-life of a variety of business leaders and may also receive a tour of the office and further networking opportunities.

- To apply students must be: Year 13 -14 in Northern Ireland and have attended a state-funded, non-fee-paying school/college

- Are **first generation** to attend university in their family; **or**
- Have been eligible for free school meals in the last 6 years; **or**
- Are from a **low-income household**, **or**
- Spent a period of time in care

Ulster University UGenie 2025

The School of Biomedical Sciences at Ulster University is delighted to announce that their Garfield-Weston funded Gene Editing Academy (UGenie) is now open to all current year 13s for 2025 entry. The academy will run from Monday 4th to Friday 8th August 2025 on the Coleraine campus, with travel and lunch covered. This may be of interest to pupils studying A' level Biology or Life and Health Sciences, as the content will be consistent with aspects of the curriculum for these subjects. Overall, the course is designed to help students develop basic laboratory skills (microbiology, pipetting, DNA extraction, PCR, electrophoresis) via a number of cutting edge gene editing experiments they have developed for 'beginner genetic engineers'. UGenie will also provide an opportunity for students to gain experience studying on the Coleraine campus, where they can engage with staff, PhD researchers and current undergrads, explore facilities, and experience university life.
