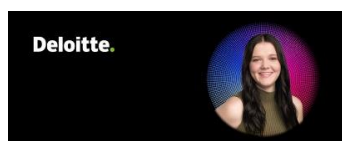

- Speech and Language Therapy

Applicants at the University of Ulster for:

- Adult Nursing
- Mental Health Nursing

will also be required to sit the MSAT Ulster, with offers made based on performance in the test.
