- Central application hub: Students create one profile and can be considered by multiple employers.
- Employer-led recruitment: Employers post apprenticeship campaigns and search the Workplus talent pool.
- Focus on higher pathways: It's commonly used for Level 4+ routes (HLAs and degree apprenticeships)
- NI-specific: Built around the Northern Ireland labour market, working alongside local colleges, universities, and employers.

The January 2026 Workplus campaign is **now live** and applications close on **20th February**. There are opportunities across the sectors and at various levels.
